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Christ's marriage to the Church

Revelation 19:6-9

6 And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! 7 Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." 8 And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. 9 Then he said to me, "Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!' " And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God."

Defining marriage

Genesis 2:18, 21-24

18 And the LORD God said, "It is not good that man should be alone; I will make him a helper [5828 help] comparable to him." ...21 And the LORD God caused a deep sleep to fall on Adam, and he slept; and He took one of his ribs, and closed up the flesh in its place. 22 Then the rib which the LORD God had taken from man He made into **a woman, and He brought her to the man**. 23 And Adam said: "This is now bone of my bones And flesh of my flesh; She shall be called Woman, Because she was taken out of Man." 24 Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

Mark 10:6-9

6 But from the beginning of the creation, God 'made them male and female.' 7 'For this reason <u>a man</u> shall leave his father and mother and be joined to <u>his wife</u>, 8 and the two shall become one flesh'; 9 Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate."

Defining marriage

Psalm 128:3-4

3 <u>Your wife</u> shall be like a fruitful vine In the very heart of your house, <u>Your children</u> like olive plants All around your table. 4 Behold, thus shall <u>the man</u> be blessed Who fears the LORD.

Submit to each other

Ephesians 5:1-3

1 Therefore be imitators of God as dear children. 2 And walk in love, as Christ also has loved us and given Himself for us, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma. 3 But <u>fornication</u> and all uncleanness or covetousness, <u>let it not even be named among you</u>, as is fitting for saints;

Ephesians 5:21-24

21 <u>submitting to one another</u> in the fear of God. 22 Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. 23 For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body. 24 Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything.

Submit to each other

Ephesians 5:25-33

25 Husbands, love [25 to love in a social or moral sense, a deliberate assent of the will as a matter of principle, duty, and propriety] your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself for her, 26 that He might sanctify and cleanse her with the washing of water by the word, 27 that He might present her to Himself a glorious church, not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing, but that she should be holy and without blemish. 28 So husbands ought to love their own wives as their own bodies; he who loves his wife loves himself. 29 For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as the Lord does the church. 30 For we are members of His body, of His flesh and of His bones. 31 "For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh." 32 This is a great mystery, but I speak concerning Christ and the church. 33 Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so **love** [25] **his own wife** as himself, and let the wife see that she **respects her husband**.

Submit to each other

Husbands, love, lead, listen, and be faithful. Wives, love, follow, listen, and be faithful.

Proverbs 18:22

He who finds a wife finds a good thing, And obtains favor from the LORD.

Philippians 2:1-5

1 Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, 2 fulfill my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. 3 Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind <u>let each esteem others better than himself</u>. 4 Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. 5 Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,

Love in marriage

Titus 2:1-5

1 But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine: 2 that the older men be sober, reverent, temperate, sound in faith, in love, in patience; 3 the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things-- 4 that they admonish the young women to **love their husbands, to love their children**, 5 to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.

Ephesians 5:22

Wives, submit [5293 to subordinate (to <u>put in a lower rank</u>), obey. From word to arrange under] to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

Proverbs 31:10, 28-31

10 Who can find a virtuous [margin: Lit., woman of valor, in the sense of all forms of excellence] wife? For her worth is far above rubies... 28 Her children rise up and call her blessed; Her husband also, and he praises her: 29 "Many daughters have done well, But you excel them all." 30 Charm is deceitful and beauty is passing, But a woman who fears the LORD, she shall be praised. 31 Give her of the fruit of her hands, And let her own works praise her in the gates.

Mark 10:42-45

42 But Jesus called them to Himself and said to them, "You know that those who are considered rulers over the Gentiles lord it over them, and their great ones exercise authority over them. 43 Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you shall be your servant. 44 And whoever of you desires to be first shall be slave of all. 45 For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many."

1 Peter 3:3-4

3 Do not let your adornment be merely outward--arranging the hair, wearing gold, or putting on fine apparel-- 4 rather let it be the hidden person of the heart, with **the incorruptible beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit**, which is very precious in the sight of God.

1 Peter 3:5-6

5 For in this manner, in former times, the holy women who trusted in God also adorned themselves, being submissive to their own husbands, 6 as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord, whose daughters you are if you do good and are not afraid with any terror [Interlinear: of whom you became children, doing good and not fearing with any consternation (confusion, amazement, frustration)].

1 Peter 3:7-9

7 <u>Husbands</u>, likewise, <u>dwell with them with understanding</u>, <u>giving honor to the wife</u>, as to the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life, that your prayers may not be hindered.

8 Finally, all of you be of one mind, having compassion for one another; love as brothers, be tenderhearted, be courteous; 9 **not returning evil for evil or reviling for reviling**, but on the contrary blessing, knowing that you were called to this, that you may inherit a blessing.

3 Let the husband render to his wife the affection due her, and likewise also the wife to her husband. 4 The wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. - Forget not to say, "I love you."

- 7. Remember that the approval of thy wife is worth more than the admiring glances of a hundred strangers. Cleave unto her and forsake all others.
- Keep thy home in good repair, for out of it cometh the joy of thy old age.
- 9. Forgive with grace, for who among us does not need to be forgiven?
- 10. Honor the Lord thy God all the days of thy life, and thy children will rise up and call thee blessed.

10 commandments for wives

- Defile not thy body neither with excessive foods, tobacco nor alcohol, that thy days may be long in the house which thy husband provideth for thee.
- Putteth thy husband before thy mother, thy father, thy daughter and thy son, for he is thy lifelong companion.
- 3. Thou shalt not nag.
- 4. Permit no one to tell thee that thou are having a hard time of it; neither thy mother, thy sister nor thy neighbor, for the Judge will not hold her guiltless who letteth another disparage her husband.
- Thou shalt not withhold affection from thy husband, for every man loveth to be loved.

10 commandments for wives, contd.

- Forget not the virtue of cleanliness and modest attire.
- 7. Forgive with grace, for who among us do not need forgiveness?
- Remember that the frank approval of thy husband is worth more to thee than the admiring glances of a hundred strangers.
- 9. Keep thy home in good order, for out of it cometh the joys of thy old age.
