

Tribulation and Rapture

Revelation 12:9

So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Amos 3:7

Matthew 24:21-22

21 For then there will be great <u>tribulation</u> [2347 pressure], such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. 22 And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened.

John 16:33

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have **tribulation**; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.

Revelation 12:6, 14

6 Then the <u>woman</u> fled into the wilderness, where <u>she has a place</u> prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days... 14 But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might <u>fly into the wilderness to her place</u>, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent.

Ephesians 5:25-27

Revelation 12:14-15

14 But the woman was given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness to her place, where she is nourished for a time and times and half a time, from the presence of the serpent. 15 So the serpent spewed water out of his mouth like a **flood** after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood.

John 7:37-39

37 On the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, "If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. 38 He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow <u>rivers of living water</u>." 39 But this He spoke concerning the Spirit, whom those believing in Him would receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified.

Not a Rapture Protected from Satan and false doctrine

Psalm 91:1-4, 9-10

1 He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High Shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the-LORD, "He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust." 3 Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence [1698 a pestilence, from 1696 ... to-speak; rarely (in a destructive sense) to subdue]. 4 He shall cover you with His feathers, And under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth shall be your shield and buckler... 9 Because you have made the LORD, who is my refuge, Even the Most High, your dwelling place, 10 No evil shall befall you, Nor shall any plague come near your dwelling;
