### Ephesians 4:28

### **Government in the Bible**

Deuteronomy 12:8-9

8 You shall not at all do as we are doing here today-every man doing whatever is right in his own eyes-- 9
for as yet you have not come to the rest and the inheritance which the LORD your God is giving you.

Romans 13:1-3

1 Let every soul be subject to the governing authorities. For there is no authority except from God, and the authorities that exist are appointed by God. 2 Therefore whoever resists the authority resists the ordinance of God, and those who resist will bring judgment on themselves. 3 For rulers are not a terror to good works, but to evil. Do you want to be unafraid of the authority? Do what is good, and you will have praise from the same.



### Government in the Bible

Exodus 18:21-22

21 Moreover you shall select from all the people <u>able men, such as fear God, men of</u> <u>truth, hating covetousness</u>; and place such over them to be rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens. 22 And let them judge the people at all times. Then it will be that every great matter they shall bring to you, but every small matter they themselves shall judge. So it will be easier for you, for they will bear the burden with you.

James 2:8-9

8 If you really fulfill the royal law according to the Scripture, "You shall love your neighbor as yourself," you do well; 9 but <u>if you show partiality, you commit sin</u>, and are convicted by the law as transgressors.

### **Government in the Bible**

Deuteronomy 17:18-20

18 "Also it shall be, when he sits on the throne of his kingdom, that <u>he shall write for himself a copy of this law in a book</u>, from the one before the priests, the Levites. 19 And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may learn to fear the LORD his God and <u>be careful to observe all the words of this law</u> and these statutes, 20 that his heart may not be lifted above his brethren, that he may not turn aside from the commandment to the right hand or to the left, and that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he and his children in the midst of Israel.
