Peacemakers

Matthew 5:9, 13-16

9 Blessed are the <u>peacemakers</u>, For they shall be called sons of God... 13 You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. 14 You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 <u>Let your light so shine before men</u>, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Isaiah 2:1-4

1 The word that Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem. 2 Now it shall come to pass in the latter days That the mountain of the Lord's house Shall be established on the top of the mountains, And shall be exalted above the hills; And all nations shall flow to it. 3 Many people shall come and say, "Come, and let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, To the house of the God of Jacob; He will teach us His ways, And we shall walk in His paths." For out of Zion shall go forth the law, And the word of the Lord from Jerusalem. 4 He shall judge between the nations, And rebuke many people; They shall beat their **swords into plowshares**, And their spears into pruning hooks; Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, Neither shall they learn war anymore.

Peacemakers

Acts 24:14-15

14 But this I confess to you, that according to <u>the Way</u> which they call a sect, so I worship the God of my fathers, believing all things which are written in the Law and in the Prophets. 15 I have hope in God, which they themselves also accept, that there will be a <u>resurrection of the dead</u>, both of the just and the unjust... 25 Now as he reasoned about <u>righteousness</u>, <u>self-control</u>, <u>and the judgment to come</u>, Felix was afraid and answered, "Go away for now; when I have a convenient time I will call for you."

Promoting peace

Nehru: Peace is not merely the absence of war. It is also a state of mind. Lasting peace can come only to peaceful people.

John 14: 25-27

25 "These things I have spoken to you while being present with you. 26 But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you. 27 Peace I leave with you, My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Matthew 18:32-33

32 Then his master, after he had called him, said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you all that debt because you begged me. 33 **Should you not also have had compassion on your fellow servant, just as I had pity on you?'**

Galatians 5:22-23

22 But the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, <u>peace</u>, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law.

Peace from obeying God's laws

Acts 20:35

35 I have shown you in every way, by laboring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is **more blessed to give than to receive**.' "
